



Dear Commuters,

Our annual fare increase will take effect on Friday, September 1, 2017. The increase will affect fares on one-way, round trip and commuter/multi-ride tickets.

In our January 2017 issue of the Commuter Newsletter we wrote about Act 89 of 2013 (the Transportation Bill) going into effect; this Bill increased the PA State Tax on Gasoline and Diesel Fuel as of January 1, 2017. We issued the announcement that our 2017 Annual Fare Assessment would host the effects of the Transportation Bill.

As a result of the Transportation Bill, and the rise in overall business operating expenses, including expenses relating to the cost of updating and maintaining our fleet, and increased tire and insurance prices, a modest increase is necessary.

We maintain our goal to keep costs low, while providing the safest, most convenience and cost-effective service possible while updating our fleet little by little each year.

Commuter / multi-ride fares will continue to be priced on a monthly basis. Our monthly commuter fares are based on the fluctuating cost of diesel fuel.
