## Doylestown/Flemington Schedules Now Operating with Reservations

On April 3, Trans-Bridge Lines began operating with reservations on our Doylestown/Flemington Schedules. This change means the date and run time on boarding passes confirms the passenger's ticket for that motorcoach. It is no longer necessary to arrive extra-early to secure a place in line and a seat on your intended bus.

We are happy to report that the transition has gone smoothly for our passengers. As we make enhancements to our online ticketing system, we will incorporate more of our schedules to this system. The next schedule to convert will be our Wall Street routes and then our Allentown/Clinton/New York Schedules.

At this time, there is no definitive date in place for these next changes. We are most focused on ensuring that our passengers experience will be smooth and that all aspects of their travel is improved. We have taken steps to upgrade our connectivity at the Port Authority Bus Terminal and are working with our technology vendor to allow our commuters the ability to choose alternate locations on their Commuter Passes to accommodate work schedules. We will also be adding the ability to store boarding passes on Google or Apple Wallet for ease in presenting QR codes to our drivers. These updates take time to complete and will need extensive testing before releasing.

In the meantime, we encourage all passengers to get into the practice of scheduling their tickets exactly as they intend to use them. For those who do not have accounts, please consider creating one at www.transbridgelines.com. Accounts are secure and allow customers to manage their purchases, store payment information, and most importantly, reschedule boarding passes as needed.

We thank our Doylestown/Flemington passengers for their patience and cooperation in being the first to make this change with us. We invite you to take a short survey to offer your feedback. Your opinion matters to us and your constructive criticism is used to improve our service for you and your fellow passengers!

## A Word on Personal Space

Personal space on a motorcoach is a difficult topic of discussion. You've paid for a ticket and want your space. After a few stops, the bus may fill up and someone sits next to you. They aren't touching you and you are not touching them. You expect the journey to go without incident.



As the ride progresses, people have the need to move their legs, stretch somewhat. You shuffle a little closer to the window to accommodate them. Personal space, y'know?

Now your seat mate is shuf-

fling their legs around, to the point of distraction. As people get off the bus, they move closer to allow passengers to move down the aisle and off the bus. You're moving closer to the window. They have now crossed the border- that bump of fabric separating your seats, and you are as close to the window as you can be. What do you do?

1. **Ask for space.** Kindly, point out that you need a bit more space- would they mind moving over a tad if they able. Don't demand or be confrontational. It is not worth the altercation.

#### 2. Err on the side of

giving space. Sitting in close proximity is a known part of riding the bus. Determine if you are comfortable enough to get to your destination without addressing the space invader. Maybe they are taller or larger and you don't mind accommodating their need for a bit of extra space.

3. **Change your seat.** If seats have opened up, you have the perfect opportunity to simply say 'Excuse me' and find a more comfortable seat.

4. Note body language. If your neighbor appears

aggressive or tense, you may want to rethink speaking with them to avoid any escalation.

#### 5. Make the driver aware.

We understand that you may not want to engage the driver when they are operating the bus, however, if you have attempted to talk politely to your neighbor and they begin to yell at you or threaten you, must take measures to protect yourself. If necessary, the driver will pull over, separate passengers, or call authorities to physically remove any passenger who poses a danger to other passengers or the driver.

# **Authorized Stops**

Driver are prohibited from making any extra stops not authorized by our Operations Department or from making any special stops requested by the passenger.

Make Self-Care a Priority. Exercise daily, get plenty of rest, address your own needs and feelings regularly, and make an effort to eat healthy.


