The following changes were implemented beginning Monday, October 20, 2025:

Allentown/Clinton/New York:

> Run 160 (Fridays only) operates to the Lehigh Valley Airport, arriving at approximately D7:45 PM.

Doylestown/Flemington:

- > Runs 5 and 11 will depart 15 minutes earlier.
- > Runs 12 and 16 reflect updated arrival and departure times.

Changes were made to eastbound runs on the Doylestown/Flemington Schedule to maintain our published arrival time to New York and westbound runs to accurately portray our actual arrival time to stop locations. These changes are a result of increased traffic in and out of the City.

















At Trans-Bridge Lines, we're committed to making travel convenient and affordable for all our passengers — including seniors. If you **qualify for a senior fare**, here's how to apply it when purchasing tickets, whether online or in person.

Online Ticket Purchases

- Visit our <u>website</u> and in the white ticket purchase box, enter your departure and arrival locations, and date. On the *Passenger* drop-down menu select *Senior/Military/Disabled*.
- Click Search and select your desired run time from the list of offerings.
- Complete your payment. Your Reduced Fare will be applied, and your ticket will be ready to print, save digitally, or access from your Trans-Bridge Lines account.

In-Person Purchases

 Visit any Trans-Bridge Lines ticket office or staffed location.

- Ask for a senior fare ticket and provide a **valid ID or proof of age**.
- Pay for your ticket. The discount will be applied immediately, and your ticket will be printed on the spot.

Important Tips

- Always have a valid ID or proof of age available, whether booking online or in person.
- Senior fares may not be combined with other promotions or discounts.
- Booking in advance is recommended to confirm your seat, especially during peak travel times.

By following these simple steps, seniors can enjoy the convenience, comfort, and affordability of Trans-Bridge Lines travel.

Things to Know ...


The Lehigh Valley Airport does not sell Trans-Bridge Lines tickets and cannot issue parking permits for our designated lot. All ticket purchases and parking permits must be obtained directly through Trans-Bridge Lines.

Reminder: Parking Permits Required Lot at LVIA

Trans-Bridge Lines would like to remind passengers that a valid parking permit is required to park in our designated lot at Lehigh Valley International Airport, located near the intermodal bus loop.

✓ Valid Permits

Only blue parking permits are valid. When printing the permit, a black and white copy is acceptable.



✓ Invalid Permits

The old white plastic permits have not been accepted since October 3, 2022. We also no longer issue gold long-term parking permits.

✓ Altered Permits

Permits with whiteouts, cross outs, or handwritten modifications to dates are not permitted.

✓ Permit Rates

First 3 Days: Parking is free, but a permit is still required.

Day 4 and Beyond: \$5 per day thereafter (rates subject to change).

Commuter Pass Holders: Parking permits are free for the duration of the pass.

Obtaining Permits

In-Person: Visit our Main Office at 2012 Industrial Drive, Bethlehem, approximately one mile from the airport. Office hours are Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

If we determine a payment is due, you will be contacted by one of our representatives before the permit is issued.

Permits sent via email will need to be printed and displayed on your vehicle's dashboard or rear view mirror.

Citations

All violators will be ticketed and/or towed at the owner's expense. The lot is owned and patrolled by the Lehigh Northampton Airport Authority. Trans-Bridge Lines cannot rescind any citations issued. Passengers will need to contact the Airport Authority directly at 800-359-5842 to inquire about resolutions.



Commuter Pass Holders

16-Hour Reschedule and Cancellation Window

Did you know that Commuter Pass holders are afforded the ability to reschedule or cancel a ticket up to 16 hours after a missed run?

If a scheduled trip is missed, passengers have that timeframe to reschedule or cancel the unused ticket. Tickets eligible for rescheduling or cancellation can be found by logging into your account and navigating to My Trips → Past. It will no longer be found in My Trips → Upcoming.

If the ticket is not rescheduled or canceled within the 16-hour window, it becomes null and void and is no longer valid for travel or refund.

Passengers are encouraged to review their travel plans promptly following a missed trip to ensure their ticket remains eligible for adjustment.

Know Your Risk Factors

Breast cancer risk is influenced by a mix of genetic, hormonal, and lifestyle factors. Age, being female, and a family history of breast or ovarian cancer are major contributors.

Inherited mutations such as BRCA1 and BRCA2 greatly increase risk. Hormonal factors, including early menstruation, late menopause, or hormone therapy, also play a role.

Additionally, obesity, alcohol use, and physical inactivity can elevate risk.

While some factors are beyond control, maintaining a healthy weight, limiting alcohol, and staying active can help reduce the chance of developing breast cancer.

Items Placed on Bus Seats - X

Passenger comfort and safety are always our top priorities. With this in mind, we wish to reiterate our expectations regarding all personal items and bags. They should only be stored overhead, under your seat, or in the lower luggage bay of the bus.

Placing bags, coats, or other belongings on empty seats is not permitted. Doing so prevents other passengers from finding available seating as they board and can create unnecessary congestion in the aisle.

More importantly, keeping the seating area clear helps ensure everyone's safety. In the event the driver must brake suddenly, loose items can shift or become dangerous projectiles. Properly stowing your belongings reduces



that risk and helps maintain a safe, comfortable environment for everyone on board.

We also ask for your courtesy and cooperation toward fellow passengers. Making space for others and following onboard guidelines helps us provide a smoother, more enjoyable ride for all.
